

The Regular Meeting Of The Board Of Commissioners Met  
Tuesday Evening In The Town Hall, May 12, 1964 At 7:30  
P.M.

Two Members of the Board were present for the meeting,

J.Paul Wilson, Mayor  
S,E,Nelon,Commissioner

The Mayor called the meeting to order.

The minutes of the last meeting were approved.

The business on the agenda, the Mayor read a letter  
form Richard Washburn of Lake Lure, asking permission  
to erect new signs on the Washburn Road, signs of  
special design and type, these signs to be placed with  
the approval of the Town Board.

A motion was made and seconded, that Mr. Washburn be  
permitted to erect signs designating Washburn Road.,  
signs of his design and type and be placed on the Road  
at his discretion. The Clerk was instructed to give Mr.  
Washburn this information.

The Mayor read letters form Mr. W.R.Hackett, Jr, Mr.J.V.  
Bell, Mrs, Thelma Powers and Lee L.Powers endorsing the  
contribution by the Town of Lake Lure to the Gorge  
Voluntary Fire Department for the new fire truck. It was  
agreed by Board members that the Town should have a letter  
from the Fire Department stating that one (1) truck would  
be housed in the Town, if and when a suitable building  
is provided. The Mayor agreed to contact the Fire Deptt.  
for such a letter. When the Town receives such a letter,  
a contribution of \$500.00 will be given to the Dept. and  
will be charged to the Beach House expenses for the 1963  
1964 fiscal year.

A motion was made and seconded that, one member of the  
garbage crew stop by the Town Office each pick-up day for  
for complaint information. The Garbage Lease will be re-  
newed on the same basis as last year, no increase in  
amount of pay. \$175.00 per month, two pick-ups per week  
for the summer months, May 15- Sept., 15, one pick-up  
during the winter months. Lease date, June 15, 1964-  
June 15, 1965.

Office Lease to be renewed for one year on the same terms  
as the 1963-1964 lease. \$600.00 per year; \$300.00 June 1st  
and \$300.00 December 1, 1964. Water and lights furnished.  
This subject to the approval of J.R.Washburn, Sr.

The Beach House operator for the 1964 season will be Mrs.  
Ada Lawter, she will be paid \$55.00 per week (6days),  
Robert L.Laughter will be senior lifeguard, Howard Duncan  
will be asst. lifeguard. Robert will be paid \$55.00 per  
six(6)day week and Howard will be paid \$45.00 for six days.  
Linda Kay Nelon will be gate keeper and will be paid  
\$30.00 for five(5) days per week.Extra help to be chosen.

The clerk was instructed to include \$2500.00 in the 1964-1965 fiscal year budget for new equipment for the street department.

No other business the meeting adjourned.
