

A Regular Meeting Of The Town Board Was Held in The
Town Hall September 14, 1965 At 7:30 P.M.

Commissioner Franks were present for the Meeting.

A group of Chimney Rock Citizens were present for the meeting and ask the Town Board of Lake Lure to consider Annexing the Village of Chimney Rock into the Corporate Limits of the Town.

This proposal was discussed at length, the Mayor told the group the Financial Condition of the Town, the bonded indebtedness of the Town and that they would be assuming and would be compelled to help pay off this debt. Mayor Wilson ask, why they wished to become a part of the Town of Lake Lure ?. Their reason was, the combined population of the Village and the Town would entitle the Area to a greater share of Federal Funds for Recreation and Sewage Improvements.

No action was taken on the Proposal at this meeting. Further discussion will be held at later meeting.

The group said that the Village could be Annexed by one of three ways, by vote of the people, by Legislative Procedure, or by Provisions as set forth in the Town Charter.

Discussion of the paving of Avenue A was deferred to a later meeting, all parties not in agreement at this meeting.

A letter was read from J.V.Bell referring to the water shortage at his residence, the letter was discussed. At present the Board is planning a 100,000 gal. reservoir near the Chalet Club to be ready for the 1966 season.



The Board granted \$250.00 for the Golf Tournament to be held in October. Money to be used for prizes and food.

The Board decided that December 1, 1965 would be date for lowering the Lake for dock and boat hosue repairs. Lake to remain down for a period of 30 days, longer if, more time needed.
