MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE Tuesday, December 12, 1967

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held in the Town Hall at 7:30 o'clock P. M. on December 12, 1967; the following members of the Board were present:

The Mayor, J. Paul Wilson, called the meeting to order and the Clerk read the minutes of the last meeting. The minutes were read and approved as written.

Mayor Wilson opened the meeting for discussion on the subject of the number of days off to be given the Town maintenance crew during the Christmas season. Motion was made, seconded and unanimously passed that the Municipal Maintenance Crew be given Friday, December 22, 1967 and Monday, December 25, 1967 as paid holidays.

Upon motion made, seconded and unanimously passed, the Town Attorney was instructed to prepare a resolution requesting the Commissioner of Motor Vehicles of North Carolina, and the State Highway Patrol to station a patrolman in the Lake Lure area to take the place of Trooper D. J. Caudle, who has been transferred.

Upon motion made, seconded and passed the Town Attorney was instructed to prepare a resolution expressing the appreciation of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure to William B. Lentz, Loren R. Fisher and Charles A. Speed, Trustees for the Members of the Western Division of the North Carolina State Highway Patrol and to the Members of the Western Division of the North Carolina State Highway Patrol for the conveyance to the Town of Lake Lure of a tract of land consisting of 2.36 acres and embracing the "Penn Memorial Lodge".

Upon motion made, seconded and unanimously passed, the Town Attorney was instructed to prepare a resolution expressing the appreciation of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure to the Northwestern Bank for opening a branch bank in the Town of Lake Lure.

After discussion, the Town Attorney was instructed to write the Western North Carolina Scenic Railroad with respect to rent due the Town of Lake Lure.
