

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF  
THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE  
TUESDAY, MARCH 12, 1968

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held in the Town Hall at 7:30 o'clock P. M. on March 12, 1968. The following members of the Board were present: J. Paul Wilson, Mayor; Robert B. Jones, Commissioner; Hollis M. Owens, Jr., Town Attorney.

Woodrow Price, Commissioner, was absent.

The Mayor, J. Paul Wilson, called the meeting to order and the clerk read the minutes of the last meeting. The minutes were read and approved as written.

Mayor Wilson opened the meeting for discussion on the subject of buying new mowers for the fairways of the Lake Lure Golf Course. The Board was advised that the mowers would cost approximately \$900.00. Upon motion made, seconded and passed, the Board agreed to buy new mowers and to trade-in the old ones.

The Board approved the payment of the rent on the Town office for the month of February, 1968, and agreed to pay \$60.00 per month for said space until they make a decision as to permanent office space for the Town of Lake Lure.

Upon motion made, seconded and passed, the following people were appointed by the Board to serve on a committee to investigate sewage connection charges, and monthly fees for individual homes, business places, motels, inns and camps, and to report to the Board its findings and recommendations:
