Mayor Wilson opened the meeting for discussion on the subject of the employment of a head life guard and an Assistant Life Guard. Upon motion made, seconded and unanimously passed, the Board agreed to hire Forest Lawter as head life guard and Linda Leslie as Assistant life guard.

The budget for the fiscal year 1968-1969 was read and discussed. Upon motion made, seconded and unanimously passed, the Board agreed to add \$2500.00 to the budget for planning and zoning of the Town of Lake Lure.

The Clerk advised the Board that Mr. Robert Thomas of Chimney Rock had asked permission to use the concrete slab on the Lake Lure beach for the purpose of conducting a weekly auction sale. Upon motion made, seconded and passed, the Board agreed to allow Mr. Thomas to use the concrete slab for auction sales on a temporary basis.

Upon motion made, seconded and passed, the Board agreed to give Willard Searcy, the operator of the Lake Lure Hydro-electric plant, a \$50.00 monthly increase in salary.
