## MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE FEBRUARY, 9, 1971

The regular meeting of the board of commissioners was held in the Town Hall at 7:30 P. M. on February 9, 1971. The following members of the Board were present: J. Paul Wilson, Mayor; Robert B. Jones, Commissioner; Woodrow Price, Commissioner. Hollis M. Owens, Jr., Town Attorney was also present.

The matter of whether to offer for sale a leasehold interest in the property owned by the Town of Lake Lure which lies between the land owned by John B. Monday and wife, Mavis R. Monday came up for discussion.

After discussion, Commissioner Jones moved, seconded by Commissioner Price that the resolution appended hereto regarding the sale of a leasehold interest in the above mentioned property of the Town of Lake Lure be adopted.
