

MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE
Tuesday, July 13, 1971

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held in the Town Hall at 7:30 o'clock, P. M. on July 13, 1971. The following members of the Board were present: J. Paul Wilson, Mayor; Avery T. Cashion, Jr., Commissioner; Zeb V. Dalton, Commissioner.

Hollis M. Owens, Jr., Town Attorney, was also present.

The Mayor, J. Paul Wilson, called the meeting to order and the Clerk read the minutes of the last meeting. The minutes were approved as written.

Mr. Richard Washburn, Mr. Martin Ives Goodman, and Mr. Freno Blankenship, citizens of the Town of Lake Lure were present.

The Mayor recognized Mr. Washburn who explained the safety marker system which is now being placed on the lake known as Lake Lure and advised that this system is now being used on all the inland waters of North Carolina for the safety of the boating public. Mr. Washburn further advised that markers have been placed around the swimming area and will be placed near the dam and in the channel leading into the main part of the lake.

Mr. Blankenship stated that he was opposed to any markers being placed in Cane Creek Cove.


Mr. Blankenship asked permission to have access to the Lake Lure Garbage Dump for the purpose of hauling refuse to said dump. He was advised that the Town of Lake Lure has entered into a contract with Mr. Sidney Nelson under which Mr. Nelson has charge of the Lake Lure Garbage Dump and that his request would have to be directed to Mr. Nelson.

Upon motion of Commissioner Cashion, seconded by Commissioner Dalton and unanimously passed the Clerk was instructed to write a letter to all persons being furnished water by the Lake Lure Municipal Water Supply advising such persons of the new water rates established by ordinance adopted by the Board on June 8, 1971, and to mail one of such letters with each 1971 water bill.

Upon motion of Commissioner Dalton, seconded by Commissioner Cashion, and unanimously adopted the Board voted to give a 1½% discount for all 1971 taxes paid during the month of July, 1971.

Upon motion of Commissioner Cashion seconded by Commissioner Dalton, and unanimously adopted the Clerk was instructed to take all steps necessary to keep the two inboard boats owned by Camp Pinewood off the lake known as "Lake Lure" unless and until Camp Pinewood purchases permits as required by the schedule of fees for permits adopted by the Board of Commissioners on November 10, 1970.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 10:30 o'clock P. M.
