MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE TUESDAY, OCTOBER 12. 1971

The regular meeting of the board of commissioners was held in the Town Hall at 7:30 o'clock P. M., on October 12, 1971. The following members of the board were present: J. Paul Wilson Mayor; Commissioners Avery T. Cashion, Jr. and Zeb V. Dalton.

Mayor Wilson presided and called the meeting to order. The Clerk read the minutes of the last meeting. The minutes were approved as written.

Several citizens of Lake Lure were present for the meeting including Mr. F. M. Blankenship. Mayor Wilson recognized Mr. Blankenship for any remarks he wished to make regarding the use of privately owned golf carts on golf courses outside of the Town of Lake Lure. Mr. Blankenship stated that privately owned golf courses could prevent the use of privately owned carts on such courses, but that he felt that municipally owned golf courses owed the tax payer the courtesy of permitting the use of private carts.

Bids submitted for the paving of Cane Creek Road and Ridge View Road were discussed. The board was advised that the bid of A. R. Thompson Construction Company on Cane Creek Road was \$7,579.00 and that the bid of Hendersonville Paving Company on said road was \$8,295.70. The board was further advised that the bid of A. R. Thompson Construction Company on Ridge View Road was \$924.00, and that the bid of the Hendersonville Paving Company on the same road was \$1,524.30. No decision was reached to have the road paved this year.

The purchase of fish for restocking Lake Lure was discussed. Upon motion of Commissioner Cashion, seconded by Commissioner Dalton, and unanimously adopted the board decided to match up to a maximum of \$500.00 fund contributed by interested parties and organizations for purchasing fish to restock Lake Lure.

Upon motion of Commissioner Dalton, seconded by Commissioner Cashion, and unanimously adopted the board voted to lower the level of Lake Lure on November 15, 1971, and to maintain the said Lake at low level until January 1, 1972.

The Clerk advised the board that the 1971 deliquent tax sale was held on September 13, 1971, at 12:00 o'clock, Noon, at the Courthouse door in Rutherfordton, N. C. and that there were no bids placed at said sale.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 11:00 c'clock P. M.
