

MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE
TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 21, 1972

The regular November, 1972, meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held in the Town Hall at 7:30 p.m. on November 21, 1972. The following members of the board were present: J. Paul Wilson, Mayor; Avery T. Cashion, Jr., Commissioner; and Zeb V. Dalton, Commissioner. Hollis M. Owens, Jr., Town Attorney, was present.

Mayor J. Paul Wilson called the meeting to order and the Clerk read the minutes of the regular meeting held on October 10, 1972. The minutes were approved as written.

The Clerk advised the board of receipt of a letter from Mrs. Lucille Hague relating to trash and debris which has collected near Yacht Club Island. Mayor Wilson expressed the opinion that this condition could be taken care of when the lake known as Lake Lure is lowered in December, 1972, to permit repairs to boat houses and docks.

Upon motion of Commissioner Dalton, seconded by Commissioner Cashion, and unanimously adopted the Board fixed the prices to be charged for boating and fishing licenses for the 1973 season at the same rates charged for the 1972 season and instructed the Clerk to have boating and fishing licenses printed for the 1973 season and to order boat stickers for the 1973 and 1974 seasons.

Upon motion of Commissioner Cashion, seconded by Commissioner Dalton, and unanimously adopted the board instructed the Clerk to send a donation in the amount of \$200.00 to the Shelby Skin and Scuba Divers Club of Shelby, North Carolina, for the assistance of its members in locating leaks in the trunk sewer line under the lake known as Lake Lure the said sum of \$200.00 to be paid out of non-tax revenues.

Upon motion of Commissioner Cashion, seconded by Commissioner Dalton and unanimously adopted the board voted to let employees of the Town of Lake Lure off on December 22, 1972 and December 25, 1972, for Christmas, and to give said employees the equivalent of one days pay as a Christmas Bonus and to give fruit baskets to each of said employees.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 10:00 o'clock p.m.
