## MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING OF BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE MAY 8, 1973

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held in the Town Hall at 7:30 o'clock P. M. on May 8, 1973. The following members of the Board were present: J. Paul Wilson, Mayor; Avery T. Cashion, Jr., Commissioner and Zeb V. Dalton, Commissioner. Hollis M. Owens, Jr., Town Attorney, was also present.

Mayor Wilson presided and called the meeting to order. The minutes of the last meeting were read and approved as written.

Mr. W. R. Hackett was present and asked the Board to purchase an ad in a service directory being prepared for businesses in the Hickory Nut Gorge. Upon motion of Commissioner Cashion, seconded by Commissioner Dalton and unanimously adopted, the Board voted to purchase a \$25.00 ad in said service directory.

Mr. Hackett told the Board that the Hickory Nut Gorge Civic Club would purchase stone to be placed on the parking area of the recreation center property owned by the Town of Lake Lure, provided an arrangement could be made to haul said stone. He was advised that the Town of Lake Lure would haul said stone.

Mr. Hackett reported to the Board that a part of Sidney Lanier Drive is in need of repairs. He was advised that said road would be stoned.

It was also reported to the Board that Boys Camp Road, Thomas Edison Road and streets in Manor Court are in need of special work.

The Board was advised that the Chimney Rock Baptist Church has requested permission to place a small movable building on property owned by the Town of Lake Lure. The purpose of said building is for the storage of materials to be used for outdoor church services held on Sunday mornings during the summer months, and said building is to be moved away after Labor Day of each year. Upon motion of Commissioner Cashion, seconded by Commissioner Dalton and unanimously adopted the requested permission was granted.

There was some discussion of the estimated budget for the fiscal year 1973-74. It was suggested that the sum of \$2,000.00 be budgeted to equip a fire boat.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 10:00 o'clock P. M.
