August 23, 1977


A special meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held in the Town Hall on August 23, 1977, pursuant to waiver of notice.


The following members were present: Mayor J. Paul Wilson, Commissioners Claude R. Nelon, A.T. Cashion, Jr., and William Keller.


The meeting was held after waiver of notice as follows:




