

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING  
OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE  
TOWN OF LAKE LURE, N.C.  
OCTOBER 24, 1978

The regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held in the Community Building October 24, 1978 at 7:30 p.m. The following members were present: Mayor J. Paul Wilson, Commissioners Claude R. Nelon, A.T. Cashion, Jr and Henry R. Rainey. Town Attorney Martin L. Nesbitt, Jr. was also present.

Mayor Wilson called the meeting to order and asked for the minutes of a regular meeting, held on September 26, be read. Motion was made by Commissioner Cashion, seconded by Commissioner Nelon they be accepted as read. The vote was unanimous.

Commissioner Nelon reported the CETA program had been extended for 6 months. The Town has 2 men and 1 school age employed. He also reported the surplus equipment was sold for the following amount: dolly \$350.00, French digger \$125.00, leaf machine \$100.00.

Commissioner Cashion reported there has been no progress on the new water line. He stated that when work resumes on the line, additional men would have to be hired.

Mayor Wilson recognized Harry Hammett--a member of the Fire Protection Association. The Board members explained to Mr. Hammett why they want to meet with Association. Mayor Wilson said there are three things needed to be discussed: contract, equipment and building. Commissioner Nelon thanked Mr. Hammett for coming and stressed the point that a meeting needed to be set up as soon as possible. Jack Donaldson reported the fire department had answered 1 house alarm and 3 wood fires in the Bill's Creek section.


Commissioner Nelon reported the ramp has been repaired but nothing has been done about the tree at the lake.


