


MINUTES OF A SPECIAL MEETING
OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE
TOWN OF LAKE LURE, N.C.
JUNE 30, 1983


A special meeting of the Board of Commissioners was held in the Town office June 30th at 10:30 ^Qp.m. The following members were present: Mayor Charles Hicks, Commissioners David Bond, Woodrow Price and Frankie Queen.

The meeting was called to order and the only bid received for garbage service was submitted by Nelon Garbage Service who is currently under contract with the Town. They requested an increase of \$100.00 per month (\$27,000.00 per year total) and all other conditions in the contract remain the same. Motion was made by Commissioner Price, seconded by Commissioner Bond and the vote was unanimous to accept the bid.

The Board briefly discussed hiring dispatchers. It was suggested to hire one full time and two part time employees. No action was taken.

Motion was made by Commissioner Bond, seconded by Commissioner Price to recess until 4:30 p.m. Friday July 1st. The vote was unanimous.
