

MINUTES OF A REGULAR MEETING
OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS
OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE

March 26, 1985

A regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure was called to order at 7:30 p.m. in the Community Center on Tuesday, March 26, 1985. Those present were: Mayor Charles F. Hicks, Commissioners Queen, Gruver and Price, and Town Attorney Jervis Arledge.

The invocation was delivered by Dave Lide.

After the reading of the minutes of the Special Meeting of February 4th, it was noted that Dick Washburn had been re-appointed to the Lake Lure Zoning and Planning Board instead of Bob Washburn. The minutes of the Emergency Meeting of February 15th, and the Regular Meeting of February 26th were read and a motion was made by Commissioner Price, seconded by Commissioner Gruver to approve the minutes from all three meetings. The vote was unanimous.

Commissioner Queen asked to be excused from the meeting because her husband was ill. After sympathies and best wishes were extended by the Board for a fast recovery, Commissioner Queen left the meeting.

Mayor Hicks relayed a proposal from the Lake Lure Ski Club requesting that the Council consider allowing the Ski Club to hold a ski show for an hour, in the mid afternoon every Sunday. They also requested that the Town increase the entrance fee to the Beach by one dollar on Sundays, and that that money be given to the Ski Club to finance the shows. With the increase in revenue the Ski Club also intends to hold regular ski clinics operating eight hours a day, five days a week for five students a week. No action was taken at this time.


Larry Philips made the suggestion that we honor active military service people by free admission to the Beach. Commissioner Gruver agreed to take that under consideration.

A request was made in writing by Mr. Charles Moore for taxes paid on property erroneously listed to Lake Lure for the years 1982 and 1983 in the amount of \$136.68. Motion was made by Commissioner Gruver seconded by Commissioner Price to refund the \$136.68 to Mr. Moore. The vote was unanimous.


After a presentation on the Globe Theatre by Matthew McEnnerney, and an animated discussion with Mr. McEnnerney and members of the audience, the Mayor read a resolution requesting the State Legislature to allow the Town of Lake Lure to deed certain property to the "Globe Playhouse, Inc."

A motion was made by Commissioner Price, seconded by Commissioner Gruver to adopt the Resolution. The vote was unanimous.

Motion was made by Commissioner Price, seconded by Commissioner Gruver to adjourn. The vote was unanimous.
