MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE

February 23, 1987

A special meeting of the Board of Commissioners of the Town of Lake Lure was called to order at 9:30 a.m. in the Town Hall on February 23, 1987. Those present were Mayor Hicks, and Commissioners Michelon, Wildman and Karr.

Walter Rust and Helen Grubel, as members of the study group headed by Commissioner Michelon participated in the meeting. The following matters were discussed:

- 1. A new organizational chart for town personnel
- 2. An overview of the recommended systems and procedures
- 3. The need for seminars with the department heads
- and the Board of Commissioners 4. A physical inventory
- 5. Annual maintenance programs

During the dicussions Commissioner Michelon recommended the hiring of an Assistant Manager and secretarial support for the office.

Other matters discussed were:

Fairfield Mountains regarding zoning and wastewater treatment
Swingfest

After discussion the Board agreed to split the cost of the Mojjis re-zoning with John Mojjis to pay \$500.00.

The last item discussed was the E.M.S. boathouse. Commissioner Karr suggested the Town give the E.M.S. a three year lease with a three year renewal option. Considerations discussed were to have the E.M.S. landscape the area and haul the dead wood away and that the Town can have a dry hydrant in the boathouse.

Commissioner Michelon moved, seconded by Commissioner Karr to recess the meeting until March the 3rd, 1987, at 9:30 a.m. in the Town Hall. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.
