MINUTES OF THE RECESSED MEETING OF THE LAKE LURE TOWN COUNCIL

July 1, 1988

The meeting was reconvened by Mayor Pro-tem Frankie Queen at 1:30 p.m. in the Town Hall on July 1, 1988.

Those present were: Mayor Pro-tem Frankie Queen, Commissioners Alex Karr, Hugo Moirano, and Bill Wildman.

Commissioner Wildman moved, seconded by Commissioner Moirano to amend the 1987/88 Fiscal Budget according to the attached schedule. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

Motion was made, seconded and unanimously approved to enter into a public hearing on the Estimated Budget for the 1988/89 Fiscal Year. After discussion, Commissioner Wildman moved, seconded by Commissioner Moirano to close the public hearing and re-enter regular session. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

Commissioner Wildman moved, seconded by Commissioner Moirano to adopt the proposed budget for the 1988/89 fiscal year. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Commissioner Moirano moved, seconded by Commissioner Wildman to set the tax rate at \$.28 cents per \$100. valuation for the 1988 tax year. The motion passed with a unanimous vote.

The Keller's request for re-imbursement of legal fees incurred in 1986 was discussed and the Council was unanimous in its decision not to accede to their request.

Mayor Pro-tem Frankie Queen went on record saying that she was concerned with the safety of Lure Woods and Boy's Camp Road in case of fire and because of traffic conditions. Commissioner Moirano felt that the building at Lure Woods should be in compliance with the County's building code. A request was made that Paul Wilson ask Joe Goodwin his opinion of the safety of the dinner theatre.

Commissioner Moirano moved, seconded by Commissioner Karr to adjourn. The motion was unanimously approved.
