MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE LAKE LURE TOWN COUNCIL HELD THURSDAY, FEBRUARY 20, 1992 AT 9:00 A.M. AT THE LAKE LURE COMMUNITY CENTER.

Mayor Priscilla Doyle called the meeting to order at approximately 9:00 a.m. The first item of discussion pertained to the selection process of the new Chief of Police. Mr. Hord asked Council for approval to advertise the key ideas for the Chief of Police position in the March League Letter. The applications shall be submitted to the attention of the Town Clerk. There will be a preliminary screening of applicants to narrow down to the qualified candidates in job skills, technical qualifications, etc. Hopefully we will be able to hire someone within one month after the closing date on applica-

Council discussed the monthly newsletter. It was the concensus of the Council to mail out the monthly newsletter to anyone requesting it by paying a \$4 per year mailing fee. The newsletter will still be distributed to local merchants for anyone wishing to pick one up. However, anyone wishing for the newsletter to be mailed each month must pay \$4 per year.

Council discussed the Marina possibly opening in March to help aid in the selling of boat and fish permits. All boat permits and fish permits will be sold at the Town Marina and Town Hall. Fish permits and daily boat permits will be made available for sale by merchants in the community.

Council discussed the water and sewer system, including rates. Mr. Hord suggested that we need to consolidate the water and sewer ordinances into one sewer use ordinance from rates to policies to procedures. Council requested that Mr. Hord work up a proposed ordinance on sewer wet-lines with specifications for the March Town Meeting. Mr. Hord asked Council to consider suggestions for the Community Center for the purpose of set-up of Town Meetings, speaker stands, etc.

It was the Consensus of the Council to hold Council workshops on Tuesday, March 3rd and Tuesday, March 17, 1992 at 9:00 a.m. at the Town Hall.

With no further items of discussion, Commissioner Bush moved, seconded by Commissioner Lehner, to adjourn. The vote of approval was unanimous.
