MINUTES OF THE TUESDAY, MAY 12, 1992 RECESSED TOWN MEETING HELD AT 9:00 A.M. AT THE LAKE LURE TOWN HALL.

Mayor Doyle called the meeting to order at approximately 9:00 a.m. Council discussed the recent boating accident. It was the consensus of the Council that the Town express its appreciation to Russ Webb, operator of the Showboat, for his help during the recent boating accident of Sunday, May 3, 1992.

Council discussed the resignation of Frank Fritts, Chief of Police and the salary of the selected applicant for the Chief of Police position. It was the consensus of the Council to permit the Town Manager to hire a new Chief of Police with a salary of up to \$32,000.

It was the consensus of the Council to send in the ICMA Recognition Application supporting the Town Manager Form of Government. Recognition is the formal acknowledgment by the membership and Executive Board of ICMA that a local government has established a position of professional management for its appointed executive.

Council briefly discussed the cost of employee benefits.

F. E. Isenhour, Zoning Administrator, recommended to Council for their consideration, that persons going before the Board of Adjustment should pay a fee of approximately \$75, and that the fees on the Lake Lure Zoning Permits be examined.

Council discussed the Golf Course. It was the consensus of the Council that the Town Manager check with Dave Pennell, Golf



Pro, to see if he would take over and handle the concessions at the Lake Lure Golf Course.

Council discussed policies pertaining to boat permits, fishing permits, boat slips, and franchise. Questions were raised as to how to handle boat slips for residents of Lake Lure. It was the consensus of the Council to have the Town Manager draw up a draft ordinance on lake use pertaining to boat permits, slips, etc., and present this draft to Council at a future regular Town meeting.

Commissioner Bush moved, seconded by Commissioner Donovan, to recess to Tuesday, May 19, 1992 at 9:00 a.m. at the Lake Lure Town Hall. The vote of approval was unanimous.
