DISCUSSION REGARDING THE TOWN OF LAKE LURE'S SEWER CAPACITY

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regards to limits on sewer capacity.

After Discussion, Commissioner Pitts made a motion to approve the sewer application from Pisgah Partners, LLC under contract with Boulder Mountain, LLC for 32 taps in Chimney Rock for property referred to as "The Boulders at Chimney Rock Subdivision".
