Re: Lake Lure & Chimney Rock Comprehensive Transportation Plan and Traffic Study

As a reminder, Town Council will convene tomorrow, May 21st from 5:00 – 7:00 pm at the Lake Lure Town Hall to review NCDOT's Comprehensive Transportation Plan ("Plan") and Traffic Study ("Study"). NCDOT will be presenting both to you for consideration and adoption.

As you may recall, in 2012 Council appointed members to the steering committee responsible for partnering with NCDOT to develop this Plan and Study. For well over a year numerous steering committee meetings were held as well as two thoroughly advertized meetings for the general public. Combined, there were approximately 250 people in attendance at these two meetings for the general public. Input was solicited and received at these well attended meetings.

In addition, the Zoning and Planning Board reviewed the Plan and Study. The Zoning and Planning Board understands both are consistent with the Town of Lake Lure 2007-2027Comprehensive Plan and the Lake Lure Town Center Master Plan (Phase 1). Both of these plans were adopted by Council 2007 and 2012 respectively. The Zoning and Planning Board had lengthy discussions about the plans at its May 14th public meeting, specifically about the Lake Lure Parkway and improvements along Old Sand Branch Road on the west side of the Lake.

In summary, the Zoning and Planning Board recommends Council review and adopt both plans, the Comprehensive Transportation Plan and the Traffic Study, as depicted. Below are links to the Plan and Study previously sent to you for review. Again, NCDOT will be presenting both to you and will be available to answer any questions you or members of the public may have tomorrow evening 5:00 – 7:00 pm here at the Lake Lure Town Hall in Council Chambers.
