

**VILLAGE OF LANSING
PUBLIC HEARING
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT APPLICATION
FEBRUARY 13, 2007**

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Podgorski called the public hearing to order at 7:30 P.M., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL Roll call revealed the following trustees present: Myers, Ryan, Eidam, DeLaurentis, Foster and Sciackitano.

HEARING Mayor Podgorski announced that this is our Community Development Block Grant presentation of application public hearing. Last Tuesday we had our call for projects and discussed the advanced schedule. Tonight we have a public hearing and immediately following the Committee of the Whole meeting we will have a special Board meeting to consider the resolution which will authorize the application to the County for Community Development Block Grant funding for 2007.

Mayor Podgorski asked Grace Bazylewski, Director of Planning and Development for the presentation of projects.

Ms. Bazylewski stated that the approved application must be submitted to Cook County no later than February 16, 2007. The Village of Lansing qualified to apply for infrastructure improvement projects.

A request being made to the County of Cook, Illinois for Community Development Block Grant (C.D.B.G.) funds for the program year 2007 in the amount of \$275,000.00 for the following capital improvements – street rehabilitation and lighting projects.

<u>PROJECT</u>	<u>AMOUNT</u>
Priority #1 Street Rehabilitation – 2 Streets (Commercial, School, between 177 th and 178 th Streets)	\$125,000.00
Priority #2 Street Lighting – 5 Blocks (Oakley, Escanaba, Commercial, School between 177 th and 178 th as well as 177 th Oakley to School)	\$150,000.00

Ms. Bazylewski stated that these are identified in the Village's C.D.B.G Program 2007 Year application and work plan. A resolution in support of the application was put forth for consideration at the Village Board meeting on the same date.

COMMENTS Mayor Podgorski asked if anyone has any questions regarding this presentation of application for C.D.B.G. funding. Hearing none Mayor Podgorski asked for a motion to adjourn.

ADJOURNMENT Being no further discussion Trustee Eidam made a motion to adjourn the public hearing for presentation of application at 7:33 P.M., seconded by Trustee Foster.
