

**VILLAGE OF LANSING
PUBLIC HEARING
COOK COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT
PERFORMANCE HEARING
NOVEMBER 13, 2007**

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Podgorski called the public hearing to order at 7:30 P.M., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL Roll call revealed the following trustees present: Abbott, DeLaurentis, Eichhorn, Eidam, Myers and Ryan.

HEARING Mayor Podgorski asked the Director of Economic Development, Grace Bazylewski to report on the Community Development Block Grant Program. Grace stated that the village is required to go through a series of public hearings for input and reporting on program participation. At the close of the reporting period the village must hold a performance hearing. This performance hearing is to report on projects open for the period ending September 30, 2007. The notice for this hearing was published as required by Community Development Block Grant regulation on October 25, 2007 in the Daily Southtown.

The Village of Lansing has two projects to report on for this public hearing.

2005 PROJECT (#05-059)
Burnham Ave. Water Services/185th St. Water Main
Grant Allocation: \$134,452.15
Expenditures: \$121,007.09
Unliquidated Obligations: \$13,445.21
Actual work completed: Installation of 6" water services, abandon existing 2" water main and elimination of lead service lines.
Project 98% completed as of reporting date.
Project 100% completed as of hearing date.

2006 PROJECT (#06-030)
Oakley, Escanaba Street resurfacing from 177th to 178th Street
Grant Allocation: \$80,000.00
Expenditures: \$40,000.00
Unliquidated Obligations: \$40,000.00
Actual work completed: Removal and replacement of curbs and gutters.
Project 16% completed.
Project 98% completed as of hearing date.

The sub grantee report has been and continues to be available for review as of this public hearing date and have been submitted to the county in September 2007. The county recommends that this public hearing serve as a call for projects for consideration for the 2008 grant cycle. All project ideas will be evaluated based on C.D.B.G. eligibility and are subject to fund availability.

In a related matter the sub grantee agreement resolution for the 2007 year funding will be on the agenda for next week's Village Board meeting for authorization of signatures.
