

**VILLAGE OF LANSING  
PUBLIC HEARING  
NPDES PERMIT PROGRAM  
JANUARY 15, 2008**

**CALL TO ORDER** Mayor Podgorski called the public hearing to order at 7:30 P.M., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

**ROLL CALL** Roll call revealed the following trustees present: Abbott, Eichhorn, Myers, Eidam and DeLaurentis. Trustee Ryan was absent.

**HEARING** Mayor Podgorski stated this is a hearing to discuss the Village of Lansing's requirements from the National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System Permit Program and turned the public hearing over to Jeff Pintar our engineer from Robinson Engineering.

Mr. Pintar explained all six required minimum control measures which are:

1. Public education and outreach
2. Public involvement and participation
3. Illicit discharge detection and elimination
4. Control of construction site storm water runoff
5. Post-construction storm water management
6. Pollution prevention/good housekeeping

Mayor Podgorski asked if these requirements are for all municipalities. Jeff replied yes.

Mayor Podgorski asked if any board members or anyone in the audience have any questions. Being none Mayor Podgorski advised the board we will have the two necessary ordinances on the agenda for the next board meeting.

**ADJOURNMENT** Being no further discussion Trustee DeLaurentis made a motion to adjourn the public hearing at 7:44 P.M., seconded by Trustee Eidam.
