

**VILLAGE OF LANSING
PUBLIC HEARING
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT APPLICATION
FEBRUARY 17, 2009**

CALL TO ORDER Mayor Podgorski called the public hearing to order at 7:30 P.M., followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

ROLL CALL Roll call revealed the following trustees present: Abbott, Eichhorn, Myers, Ryan, Eidam and DeLaurentis.

HEARING Mayor Podgorski announced this is our Community Development Block Grant Application public hearing. Last week we held our normal Call for Projects as the Village seeks to apply for C.D.B.G funds for use in the appropriate areas in our community that meet the requirements for C.D.B.G. funding. Tonight we have our application to discuss and after the hearing whether we make any changes or not the resolution will be on the agenda later in the evening for a vote because we have to get it to the county sometime later this week... Mayor Podgorski turned the meeting over to Planning and Development Director Grace Bazylewski.

Grace stated we are applying for two projects for a total of \$300,000.00. Project Priority #1 – the estimate project cost is \$155,000.

Project Description:

The project consists of the installation of 24 street lights along approximately 4400 lineal feet of roadway in multifamily residential areas.

Project Priority #2 – the estimate project cost is \$145,000.00.

Project Description:

The project consists of the installation of 22 street lights along approximately 3100 lineal feet of roadway in multifamily residential areas.

In both of these cases there is currently no lighting or lighting provided at marginal quality by Com Ed installation. The efficiency of new streetlight installation will contribute to reduced energy costs for the village.

The proposed projects will provide illumination of the streets and parkways in accordance with village lighting standards. These lighting installations will provide
