Secretary of State Mobile Unit Coming to Lockport

Jesse White's "mobile driver's license" facility will be here from 9:30 a.m. to 2:30 p.m., for the following: vision screening, written examinations (CDL not available), duplicate licenses, corrected licenses, driver's license renewal, identification cards, and license plate renewal stickers (past, present, and upcoming month only). If you need any of these services, please come to Central Square's lobby at 222 E. Ninth Street on either April 20, 2010 or October 19, 2010. **Please note – written and visual exams will be administered, but individuals requiring a road test will NOT be able to renew at this site.**

Prescription/Non-prescription Drug Disposal Program

The Lockport Police Department, along with the Lockport Township Government, is providing a Drug Disposal Collection location. Residents can safely dispose of their unwanted or expired medications 24 hours a day, seven days a week, into a steel depository box located inside the Lockport Police Department lobby, 1212 Farrell Road. Any old, expired prescription or non-prescription medication that you no longer need can be safely disposed of at our collection site. Acceptable prescription and non-prescription medications include pills, salves, and liquid medications in original containers. Items not in original containers must be packaged in non-leaking containers. Unacceptable items include sharps, needles, IV bags, thermometers and medical waste. The prescription and non-prescription drug disposal program is anonymous and does not require any identification to deposit medications. The goal of this program is to keep our environment and residents safe from the harmful effects of improper disposal of medications. The medications will be taken to an EPA-approved location for safe disposal.
