

Proposal A – Current Refuse and Recycling Program

Description of Proposed Services:

Refuse Cart Program: Provide current residents with 64-gallons refuse carts. Weekly collection of refuse placed in carts, bags or additional 32-gallon containers. One bulk item collection per week. Residents have the option of renting an additional 64-gallon refuse cart for \$2.00/month through the City.

Recycling Services: Service residents with a 35-gallons recycling carts with once per week collection. White goods collected once per week at no charge. The new standard recycling container size would be 64-gallons for most replacements and new properties which would be phased in over time. Seniors would retain the 35-gallon carts.

Yard Waste Service: Collection of yard waste material in kraft-type paper bags from April 1 through the week in which November 30th occurs with a \$2.50 prepaid sticker attached through the November 30, 2013. The sticker price April 1, 2014 would be \$2.75. Residents have the option of renting a 96-gallon yard waste cart through Waste Management for an annual fee.

Commercial Services: Waste Management will provide weekly commercial services to City owned buildings.

Special Event Services: Waste Management would provide the following services to the City for Special Events:

- *Roll off Services:* Provide three (3) 30-yard containers, eight (8) 20-yard roll-offs for general purposes and one (1) 10-yard container for per contract year.
- *Port-O-Let Services:* Provide for 35 standard units, 8 handicap units, 15 hand wash stations, serviced once during City sponsored special events, and one 250 gallon holding tank with one service per year. Also provide 2 standard units with weekly services from April through October at 2 locations downtown.
- *City Carts:* Provide fifty (50) 64-gallon carts with the City of Lockport Logo for the City's use.

Refuse Cart Program: Conduct a one-time upgrade of refuse carts from 64-gallons to 96-gallons for residents on a request basis. One bulk item such as a couch, chair, or mattress will be collected per week as part of the weekly collection program. Residents have the option of renting a additional 96- or 64-gallon refuse cart for \$2.00/month through the City. The new standard refuse container would be 96-gallons.

Recycling Services: Conduct a one-time upgrade of recycling carts from 35-gallons to 64-gallon for residents on a request basis. Weekly collection of recyclable material placed in or adjacent to the cart. White goods collected once per week at no charge. Residents have the option of renting a 96-gallon yard waste cart for \$2.00/month through the City. The new standard recycling container size would be 64-gallons.

Yard Waste Service: Collection of yard waste material in kraft-type paper bags from April 1 through the week in which November 30th occurs. Residents have the option of renting a 96-gallon yard waste cart through the City for \$2.00/month.

Commercial Services: Waste Management will provide weekly commercial services to City owned buildings.

Special Event Services: As provided for in Proposal A.

Refuse Cart Program: Conduct a one-time upgrade of refuse carts from 64-gallons to 96-gallon for residents on a request basis. Weekly collection of refuse placed in carts, bags or additional 32-gallon containers. One bulk item collected per week. Residents have the option of renting an additional 96 or -64 gallon refuse cart for \$2.00/month through the City. The new standard refuse container would be 96-gallons.

Recycling Services: Conduct a one-time upgrade of refuse carts from 35-gallons to 96-gallon for residents on a request basis. Recycling would be provided on an every other week basis. Additional recyclable materials may placed in carts or adjacent to the cart. White goods collected once per week at no charge. Residents have the option of renting a 96-gallon yard waste cart for \$2.00/month through the City. The new standard recycling container size would be 96-gallons.

Yard Waste Service: Collection of yard waste material in kraft-type paper bags from April 1 through the week in which November 30th occurs. Residents have the option of renting a 96-gallon yard waste cart through the City for \$2.00/month.

Commercial Services: Waste Management will provide weekly commercial services to City owned buildings.

Description of Proposed Services:

Refuse Cart Program: Conduct a one-time upgrade of refuse carts from 64-gallons to 96-gallon for residents on a request basis. Weekly collection of refuse placed in carts, bags or additional 32-gallon containers. One bulk item will be collected per week. Residents have the option of renting a additional 96 or -64 gallon refuse cart for \$2.00/month through the City. The new standard refuse container would be 96-gallons.

Recycling Services: Conduct a one-time upgrade of refuse carts from 35-gallons to 96-gallon for residents on a request basis. Recycling would be provided on an every other week basis. White goods collected once per week at no charge. Residents have the option of renting a 96-gallon yard waste cart for \$2.00/month through the City. The new standard recycling container size would be 96-gallons.

Yard Waste Service: Collection of yard waste material in kraft-type paper bags from April 1 through the week in which November 30 occurs with a \$2.50 prepaid sticker attached through the November 30, 2013. The sticker price April 1, 2014 would be \$2.75. Residents have the option of renting a 96-gallon yard waste cart through Waste Management for an annual.

Commercial Services: Waste Management will provide weekly commercial services to City owned buildings.

Proposal E – Current 64-gallon carts with USED 64-gallon recycling carts serviced once per week with weekly yard waste collection

Description of Proposed Services:

Refuse Cart Program: Provide current residents with 64-gallons refuse carts for refuse. One bulk item will be collected per week as part of the weekly collection program. Residents have the option of renting an additional 64- or 96-gallon refuse cart for \$2.00/month through the City. Seniors would retain the 64-gallon cart size.

Recycling Services: Conduct a one-time upgrade of recycling carts from 35-gallons to 64-gallon for residents on a request basis. Carts will have been previously used, however, they will be cleaned and in good working condition. Collection will be provided weekly. White goods collected once per week at no charge. The new standard recycling container size would be 64-gallons.

Yard Waste Service: Collection of yard waste material in kraft-type paper bags from April 1 through the week in which November 30 occurs. Residents have the option of renting a 96-gallon yard waste cart through the City for \$2.00/month.

Commercial Services: Waste Management will provide weekly commercial services to City owned buildings.

Residents have the option of renting an additional 64-gallon refuse cart or 96-gallon cart for \$2.00/month through the City. Seniors would retain the 64-gallon cart size.

Recycling Services: Upgrade recycling carts to 96-gallons and service recycling on an every other week basis. White goods collected once per week at no charge. The new standard recycling container size would be 96-gallons for most replacements and new properties. Seniors could retain the 35-gallon cart or upgrade to a 64-gallon cart,

Yard Waste Service: Collection of yard waste material in kraft-type paper bags from April 1 through the week in which November 30 occurs. Residents have the option of renting a 96-gallon yard waste cart through the City for \$2.00/month.

Commercial Services: Waste Management will provide weekly commercial services to City owned buildings.

- Denotes that item has a very limited market and may not be recyclable.

Weekly Yard Waste Services: Yard waste materials include the week to week accumulations of grass, leaves, twigs branches, ornamental plants that would be generated from the routine care and maintenance of laws, landscaping and gardens. Brush and branches would be collected provided that it is bundled and secured with string or twine. Bundles must not exceed 4 feet in length with a maximum weight of 50 pounds. Yard waste does not include dirt, stone, rock, whole lawn replacement, sod, tree stumps or trucks, or waste that has been generated by a contractor. Carts rented for yard waste must be clearly identified as being for yard waste.

Government and Regulatory Fees: The above prices include all current federal, state, county, local or other taxes, fees, surcharges or similar charges relating to the collection and disposal of the City's Solid Waste (the "Fees"). Any increase in the Fees or any new Fees imposed that specifically impact general business conditions or permitted pollution control facilities (i.e. landfills, transfer stations, compost facilities) following the date of this Agreement, the parties agree to negotiate in good faith any such price increases provided that the CONTRACTOR provides evidence of the increase to the City. In addition, in the event that changes with Federal or state statute or regulation, there occurs a change in the regulatory requirements which requires further separation of municipal solid waste which has general applicability to similar waste haulers and which materially increases the CONTRACTOR'S costs, the parties agree to negotiate in good faith any such price increases. In the event of any increase for the above, the increase would take effect on in conjunction with the scheduled price increase date.

Fuel Surcharge: The above prices reflect the price of fuel with an estimated diesel fuel cost of \$2.65/gallon. In the event the average price of diesel increases of more than \$3.65/gallon for a 12 month period as published by the Energy Information Administration (EIA), then the CONTRACTOR may charge a fuel surcharge not to exceed 3% of the current unit price.

Resident Survey

- 8959 surveys were mailed in late October 2010
- Over 2,200 were returned or about 25%
- Three questions were asked:
 - Preference for refuse cart size (96 or 64-gallons)
 - Preference for recycling cart size (96, 64, or 35)
 - Should the City keep the sticker program? Y or N
- Great Response – Thank you!



Survey Results

Refuse Carts – 67% were satisfied with the current 64-gallon cart

Recycling Cart– 64% (combined) wanted a larger recycling cart

Yard Waste Program – 75% wanted to eliminate the sticker program

Proposal Development

- ❖ Worked with staff to discuss the structure of 4 proposals to address future needs
- ❖ 2 more proposals were added due to recent contract changes and survey results generated for a total of 6 proposals for Council consideration.
- ❖ Discussed additional services for the City
- ❖ Some services could start as soon as April 1, 2011
