

Biking the I & M Canal Family Program Sponsored by Forest Preserve District of Will County

“Bike and Break for History—The I & M Canal,” a free, family bike ride for persons at least 12 years of age, will be Sunday, October 16, 8:00 a.m., at McKinley Woods—Kerry Sheridan Grove, in Channahon. Registration is required.

Participants will bike along the historic I & M Canal to the Forest Preserve's McKinley Woods and return, approximately 8 miles in all.

This bike tour follows 150 years of history. Riders will see Locks 6 and 7, learn about the lock tender's house at Lock 6, discover flora and fauna unique to the waterway, and explore the history of McKinley Woods.

Participants are responsible for providing their own bike, safety helmet and drinking water.

The trail is a mostly level crushed limestone surface.

McKinley Woods—Kerry Sheridan Grove is located on Blackberry Lane, south of Route 6, in Channahon.
