

Please note these pictures are to give you an idea of what the mature tree will look like. Trees offered in this program will be at least 2" to 2.5" diameter 24" above the root ball

### **Honey Locust**

- Bright green foliage turns yellow in the fall
- Leaves made up of smaller leaflets, giving lacy effect
- In fall, small leaflets fall into grass requiring little raking



### **Red Sunset Maple**

- Moderate growth rate
- Shiny green leaves in spring
- Red-orange foliage in fall
- Highly ornamental



### **Green spire Linden**

- Very suitable for street planting
- Heart-shaped leaves
- Fragrant, pale yellow flowers
- Dark green foliage turns yellow in the fall
- Symmetrical shape



### **Hackberry**

- Low water requirements, high tolerance to salt
- Withstands heat, drought, wind & alkaline soils
- Red-orange fruit in the fall
- Light green foliage in the spring



### **Norway Maple**

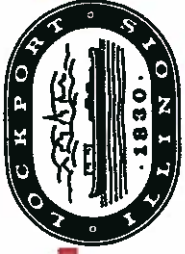
- Summer foliage is dark green
- Fall foliage is yellow
- Tolerant to salt & drought
- Suitable for street planting
- Prefers full to partial sun



### **Redmond Linden**

- Large, heart-shaped leaves
- Yellow, fragrant flowers in June -July (Caution: may attract bees)
- Medium-fast growth rate
- Becomes densely pyramidal and symmetrical with age
- Yellow foliage in the fall





# 2011 Parkway Tree Program

Lockport Public Works is offering a Spring 2011 Parkway Tree planting program. Residents have the option to purchase a parkway tree at a cost of \$60.00 per tree. Homeowners that wish to take advantage of this offer can simply fill out the order form located inside this brochure & submit with your payment to the Finance Department at 222 E. 9th Street, Lockport, IL 60441, Attn: 2011 Parkway Tree Program. Please note that payment must be received by December 31, 2010.

Public Works will plant the new parkway trees in early Spring 2011 when conditions are favorable for tree planting.

Residents may purchase additional trees at this special price for other areas of their property & plant the trees themselves. These will be delivered in Spring 2011.

\*\*Please note if you have overhead utility lines above your parkway, you are not eligible for a parkway tree. You may still purchase trees for your yard.

Parkway trees are not allowed to be placed under overhead utility lines per Ordinance No. 09-034. If you do have overhead utility lines in your parkway, you will not be able to purchase a parkway tree through this program. However, you are allowed to purchase trees for other areas of your yard, granted you do not place the tree (s) under utility lines.

Please note it is the responsibility of the homeowner to ensure the tree is properly watered. The City of Lockport is not responsible for any tree that fails to survive.
