POLICIES & PROCEDURES

- T-Shirts Each child will be given one camp t-shirt. A second t-shirt is available to purchase for an additional fee if desired. We require that each child wear
 his/her camp shirt on scheduled days when we leave the Recreation Center.
- Lunch Your child will need to bring a lunch with them each day to camp unless otherwise noted. We will provide a small morning snack daily.
- Potty Trained We require all program participants to be fully potty trained prior to registering for camp
- Parent Release Forms We must have a parent release/emergency form on file for every camper. It will be kept onsite and our staff must be notified if anyone
 other than the individual on the form is picking up your child. We will check identification cards of those individuals picking up children at the end of the day
- Injury & Illness In the event of an injury or illness, our staff will attend immediately to your child and notify you as soon as possible, depending upon the degree of the injury.
- Refunds & Cancellations If you cannot attend the camp or find the camp is not meeting your expectations, it is possible to request either a transfer or a refund. If you choose to transfer, we will apply the pro-rated amount of your enrollment fee to another camp or class. If you prefer to receive a refund, a \$15 processing fee will be deducted from the pro-rated fee based on the date of the request. In the event that the camp is cancelled, you will receive a full refund.
