Event: HOMEARAMA, a single-site new home showcase produced annually by the Home Builders Association of Greater Cincinnati. This year's show will be held at the Vintage Club, developed by Great Traditions Land and Development Company, located off Montgomery and Kemper Roads, north of the Gate of Heaven Cemetery. Ten homes will be showcased at this year's event.

Event Dates: A preview party will be held on Friday, June 8th from 6-9p.m. Admission to the preview party is by invitation only.

The event is open to public on Saturday, June 9th through Sunday, June 24th.

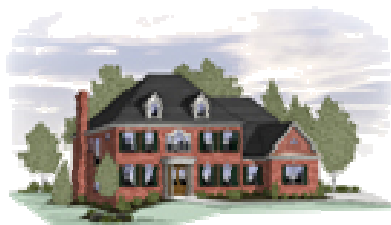
Weekday Hours: 4 p.m. to 11 p.m.

Weekend Hours: noon to 11 p.m.

Tickets: Event tickets are \$12; children 12 and under admitted free of charge when accompanied by an adult. No tickets sold for admittance to the show after 9:30 p.m.

Expected Attendance: The Home Builders Association of Greater Cincinnati estimates 100,000 guests to be in attendance at HOMEARAMA 2007 over the 16-day event.

Traffic Control: There will be two entrances to the event—one on Montgomery Road and one on E. Kemper Road. The Montgomery Road entrance will provide access for northbound traffic only. Both points of access will be staffed by off-duty police officers to assist with traffic flow. All traffic exiting the event will leave via Montgomery Road. Directional signage will be posted to assist people in finding the event.



Security: The HOMEARAMA site will be staffed 24-hours a day, 7-days a week by a private security firm during the show. Fencing will surround the entire home show site and should eliminate the potential for people to walk through or park on private properties to gain entry.

Parking: There are 12 acres of on-site parking where all HOMEARAMA guests will be directed to park. With this ample on-site parking and the fencing surrounding the site, we do not anticipate any parking problems on city streets or within the lots of city parks or businesses.

Pre-Show Work: There will be a flurry of activity at the site in the days and weeks before the opening of the show. This may include work early in the morning and later into the evening. The City's regulations which govern excessive loud noise between the hours of 10 p.m. and 7 a.m. will still apply. The City has worked with the Home Builders Association to ensure that it is aware of these regulations. Event Clean up and Maintenance: Some clean up and maintenance activities will be occurring after hours, but we do not anticipate these activities will be disruptive to you. Should you have problems associated with these activities during the event, please contact the City of Montgomery Police Department.

Montgomery Tent: The City of Montgomery will have a tent at the event to highlight some of the unique features and valued aspects of our community including our schools and our businesses. City officials, staff and volunteers will be on site each day to welcome guests and to promote our community to event participants.
