CITY DEDICATES NEW PLAZA AND HONORS VETERANS

(Montgomery, Ohio) – The City of Montgomery and the Parks and Recreation Commission will dedicate the new Triangle Point Plaza Monday. The plaza is one of the final pieces in the completion of the development of a mixed use property in the historic district by Montgomery Gateway Partners.

“The plaza is a beautiful addition to our historic heritage district,” stated Montgomery City Manager, Cheryl Hilvert.

The dedication will take place on Monday, November 12 at noon at the Triangle Point Plaza. Project participants, business owners within the plaza, and City Council will be on hand to officially open the new plaza.

The Triangle Point Plaza includes a three-tiered water fountain decorated with sycamore leaves that are representative of the city’s heritage. The fountain will be an inviting addition to the western edge of Montgomery’s heritage district.

“We are quite happy with the attractive appearance of the Triangle Point Plaza and believe it will be a source of pride for the residents of Montgomery for many years,” stated Parks and Recreation Chair, Gene Droder.

In conjunction with the dedication, a tribute ceremony recognizing veterans will take place.
