### **City Council Member Resigns...Replacement Sought**

(*MONTGOMERY, Ohio*) – On Tuesday, April 13, Montgomery Council Member Vicki Hirsch resigned her City Council seat effective immediately, citing personal and family medical issues.

Dr. Hirsch was a teacher at Montgomery Elementary School for some 30 years and served on the Sycamore Community School Board after retiring in 2003. She has served on the Montgomery Landmarks Commission, the Bicentennial Steering Commission and Board of Zoning Appeals. She served three years on Montgomery City Council.

“Vicki Hirsch has been an active and involved member of City Council and a familiar face in Montgomery for many years. She attended numerous events and meetings, frequently providing anecdotes to City Council about the people and places of interest in the City. Her dedication and enthusiasm for the community has been contagious,” commented Mayor Gerri Harbison.

City Council is currently seeking a replacement to fill out Dr. Hirsch’s unexpired term, which ends December 7, 2011, and is now accepting letters of interest from Montgomery residents until 5:00 pm on Monday, May 10. Interested applicants should submit a letter indicating their reasons for wanting to join Montgomery City Council including any current and/or prior community service experience and a resume.

To be eligible, applicants must have resided in Montgomery for at least one year prior to taking office and must be a qualified elector throughout the term of office. Interested and qualified parties should submit the required information to:
