### **Jerram Street Piano Coming to Montgomery**

(MONTGOMERY, Ohio) – “Play Me, I’m Yours,” an artwork and concept created by Luke Jerram, is coming to Montgomery. This playable work of art will be located in Parrot Alley on Montgomery Road on August 5 (for 3 weeks) and available for everyone to see and play. Already, over 130 pianos have been installed in cities across the world including London, Sydney, Barcelona, Sao Paulo, New York and now, the City of Montgomery.

Since 2008, Jerram’s street pianos have promoted a sense of community by offering unlimited opportunities for musical inspiration and community gathering. The pianos invite the public to play any time they want for as long as they want. Placing the pianos in cities offers a respite in the midst of street noise and hurrying people and creates a sense of community around an instrument of art.

“Play Me, I’m Yours” is being presented by Procter & Gamble and Cincinnati Public Radio in celebration of WGUC’s 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary, WXXU’s 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary and WMUB’s 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary.

The piano will move to other fun locations in the Cincinnati and Northern Kentucky area after its stay here in Montgomery.
