(MONTGOMERY, Ohio) – Montgomery Calls for Entries for Annual Photo Contest

The 24th Annual Montgomery Arts Commission Photo Competition is set for Sunday, March 13, 2011 and award-winning photographer, Corson Hirschfeld, will judge the entries and offer insights in capturing the perfect photo. The exhibit and awards reception will be held at the Universalist Church from 1 to 3pm.

For those who could use some assistance, Mr. Hirschfeld will discuss the various aspects of creating a pleasing print at a photography workshop slated for Saturday, March 12, 2011 from 1-4:00pm at Swaim Lodge (Corner of Cooper and Zig Zag Roads). Class is limited to 15 participants. Fees are \$35 for residents, \$45 for non-residents and \$25 for full-time students.

Every year, we have fantastic entries from local students and adults that showcase the talent of our residents. New this year to the contest is the category of “Montgomery Parks”. A “General” category is also available, but only a maximum of three photos may be entered for the competition. Pictures can be generated from film or digital files.

- Entries will be accepted at the Montgomery City Hall, 10101 Montgomery Road, between Monday, February 21 to Tuesday, March 1, 2011.
- A non-refundable entry fee of \$5.00 for students or \$10.00 for adults is required per picture.
- Cash or checks payable to the City of Montgomery are acceptable forms of payment.
