Dear Parents,

Thank you for your interest in the School's Out "Trip to Sunrock Farm." Below are details about the trip:

Where & When to Meet:

- The trip is on Friday, November 13, 2009.
- Meet & return from Swaim Park Lodge located at the lower level parking lot, on the corner of Cooper and Zig Zag Rd.
- The time of the trip is 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. We are planning to leave at 9 a.m. so please arrive 10-15 minutes prior. If we encounter an unforeseen delay in returning from the trip (ie. traffic) we will contact you on the emergency contact phone number to give you an update on our return time. We plan to return to Swaim Lodge at approximately 2:30 or 3:00 p.m. and kids will participate in a fun activity at Swaim Lodge until 4:30 p.m.
- Transportation is by Petermann bus. Our travel time on the bus is approximately 30 minutes.

What to bring:

- Extra drinks and a snack. If your child does not want the pizza that is provided, you may pack a lunch.

What to wear:

- The farm activities are outside so please have your child dress in weather appropriate and comfortable clothing and shoes however, many activities are held in a barn that has a fireplace so even if it is raining, we will still be able to enjoy the activities at the farm.

- A pizza lunch and a drink are provided and both are included in the fee. Our pizza lunch will be at the farm around noon and we will eat together either inside the barn with the fireplace or under a covered shelter.
- The tour is from 10am to 2pm and during the tour kids will experience hands on activities such as milking a goat, brushing horses, holding chicks, visiting pigs & donkeys and feeding sheep.
- There is a minimum of 15 kids needed to run the trip and there is a maximum of 35 kids. If we do not have the minimum, we may have to cancel the trip and notification of participants will be Tuesday or Wednesday, Nov 10th or 11th.
