"TAKING GREAT PHOTOGRAPHS" WORKSHOP

Take your photography to a higher level by attending this photography workshop featuring award winning photographer, Corson Hirschfeld. Corson will present the various aspects of taking a good photograph (digital or film media) through a combination of instruction, examples and discussion. To facilitate the learning process, all discussions will include the entire class.

-THE SUCCESSFUL PHOTOGRAPH-

The successful photograph is the result of many carefully considered and artfully assembled components. Corson will define the various elements of a photograph such as composition, line and form, depth of field, color palette, layering, intent and craft. He will provide concrete examples of each by using his photographs and at least one print from each participant.



No photograph is perfect, but some images have more impact on a viewer than others. The workshop will help to identify why this is so. The workshop goal is for each participant to gain a greater understanding of what makes his/her own photographs more or less successful. Cameras or processes will not be addressed but rather the resulting images. Anyone with sufficient interest and experience to enter the Montgomery Photo Contest is

qualified to participate. Ample time will be provided for questions and only constructive criticism will be permitted.

-BIOGRAPHY-

Corson Hirschfeld's photographs have appeared in magazines in the U.S., Europe, Australia and Japan, and have included *Architectural Record*, *Fortune*, *Money*, *Natural History*, *Newsweek*, *Reader's Digest*, *Smithsonian*, *Sports Illustrated*, *Omni*, *Parabola*, *Playboy*, *Psychology Today*, *US*, and the *Washington Post Magazine*.

Corson's advertising photography has been widely awarded in design and art directors' competitions and he is represented in the Archive of Advertising Photography at the International Museum of Photography. He has taught photography at the University of Cincinnati, lectured at educational and arts organizations, curated exhibitions, and has had one-person exhibitions at galleries and museums including the National Museum of Natural History and Smithsonian Institution.



-CLASS REQUIREMENTS-

Each participant is expected to bring one (3 maximum) original, mounted prints of his or her making. In addition to their own work, attendees should bring two photographs, not of their making, that they find successful,

interesting or perplexing. These can be from books, magazines or other sources and need not be mounted. Corson will discuss at least one photograph taken by each participant and additional photographs will be reviewed as time permits.

-REGISTRATION-

Registration begins February 1, 2011 and may be conducted in person at Montgomery City Hall, by mail or through the City's website. Registrations will be processed according to postmark or the order received. The registration deadline is Friday, March 4, 2011. Don't delay! The workshop is limited to 15 participants. Additional registrants will be placed on a waiting list and contacted if cancellations occur.

Montgomery's Photography Weekend also includes the 24th Annual Photography Competition and Exhibit on Sunday, March 13th, in the Universalist Church, downtown Montgomery.
