1. Minutes of meeting of September 21, 2011 were discussed.

Action: A motion was made by Stu Eaton and seconded by Mitch Abraham to approve the minutes. The motion passed unanimously.

2. David Serepka gave a presentation concerning the possibility of partnering with the Town of Mooresville in the construction of their future athletic fields.
3. Wanda McKenzie updated the board on several projects including;

- a. Cornelius Road Park construction is progressing as planned, first phase of park which includes tennis courts, playground and walking trails should be opening in November. The baseball fields will open next fall
- b. Talbert Road Recreation Center should open in December
- c. Pumpkin Run went very well with over 110 participants
- d. The Department's wrestling registration ended in October and youth are currently registering for basketball

4. Tournament deposits were discussed.

Action: A motion was made by Dan Brewer and seconded by Stu Eaton to change the department's current policy that states that half the total rent of the fields is due in advance to state that \$200 per complex is due in advance. The motion passed unanimously.

5. A discussion of the Junior Golf Program at the Mooresville Golf course was held. Dan Brewer agreed to sit in on a committee with Wanda McKenzie, and Jeremy Elliott to formally address a Town Junior Golf Proposal.
6. The Board considered a request from several youth in the area to allow BMX bikes at the Skate Park. Dan Brewer is to check with the manufacturer of the equipment concerning the bike usage.
7. The Mooresville Theater's use of the CMCC was addressed. Wanda McKenzie and Maia Setzer will discuss with Town Manager and report back to the board.
8. The board was updated on the status of the Recreation Bond Money and received a list of potential projects.
9. With no further action a motion to adjourn was made at 2:45 by John Streb and seconded by Stu Eaton.
