**Description:**

An employee in this position performs a variety of tasks related to the thickening and land applications to dispose of solids at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. This employee will assist with digester operation and plan wasting schedule; monitor sludge blankets and basin solids; adjust feed rates to maintain proper operation; clean and maintain belt press and other equipment; drive the dump truck to haul bio-solids to storage area; assist with keeping records of hours of operation, amount of bio-solids pressed and polymer used in accordance with rules and regulations; assist with digester sampling and testing with the laboratory; assist with yard waste storage area; other duties as required.

**Minimum Requirements:**

High School diploma or GED required. Mechanical and electrical aptitude, carpentry and plumbing experience helpful. Candidate needs a general working knowledge of oils, greases, hand tools and hydraulics.

**Hours:**

Monday – Friday 7:00AM to 3:30PM, may be required to work nights, weekends, overtime or adjust hours as determined by operational needs.

**Other Information:**

Possession of a Wastewater Operator's Grade III level certificate from the State of North Carolina or possession of a Land Application Certification from the State of North Carolina required within 12 months of hire. Must have a valid North Carolina Commercial Driver's License (CDL) or obtain one within 6 months of hire.
