Description:

An employee in this position typically works in a micro-computer environment and provides hardware and software support to users including but not limited to software training. Oversees WAN-hard disk back-ups, hardware and software installation, disk formatting and troubleshooting printer malfunctions. May generate ad hoc reports, develop use documentation and evaluate hardware, software and new technology to make purchase recommendations to management. Work is independently performed under the supervision of the Information Technology Manager. Must have thorough knowledge of the operation, uses and capabilities of personal computer equipment; thorough knowledge of personal computer setup, configuration and support; general knowledge of word processing, spreadsheet and presentation software; ability to understand and follow written and oral instructions; ability to install and configure networking hardware and software; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with officials, department heads, employees, general public and vendors; skill in the use of personal computer hardware and software.

Minimum Requirements:

Graduation from an accredited college or university with major course work in computer science or related field and considerable experience in networking personal computers, LAN network administration and some experience in database administration; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.
