Position: Water Treatment Plant Superintendent

Description:

An employee in this position is responsible for being in charge of the water treatment plants, for providing an adequate water supply, and for assuring water quality in the distribution system. This person ensures that water treatment plants and distribution facilities are operated in strict accordance with regulations and rules. This person performs difficult technical and supervisory work in operations, maintenance, and laboratory analysis at water treatment plants. This person serves as supervisor for the Water Treatment Plant Operator Trainees, Water Treatment Plant Operators I, II, IV, and the Water Treatment Plant Operations Supervisor; develops, submits, and tracks budgets; develops, recommends, and administers training programs; monitors status of plant operations and distribution system; serves as ORC for water treatment plants; and other duties as assigned.

Minimum Requirements:

Graduation from a community college with a degree in chemistry, environmental science or related field and five to seven years of water treatment experience, including some supervisory experience; or an equivalent combination of education and experience.

Other Information:

The work requires some physical exertion such as long periods of standing; walking over rough or difficult surfaces; recurring lifting of moderately heavy items weighing up to 20 pounds and may require occasional lifting of objects weighing in excess of 50 pounds. Required valid NC drivers' license and good driving record.
