Description:

An employee in this position is responsible for daily operation and overall supervision of the treatment plants; ensures that water treatment facilities are operated in strict accordance with regulations and rules. This person serves as plant safety director; develops, recommends, and administers training to operators; troubleshoots operational problems; performs lab tests; refills chemical holding tanks; maintains records; tracks inventory; performs routine plant maintenance; monitors the status of plant operations and distribution system; answer and resolve customer questions and complaints; and other duties as assigned.

Minimum Requirements:

High school diploma and over ten years directly related experience; or two years of college or Associate's Degree and five to less than ten years directly related experience; or a Bachelor's Degree and two to five years directly related experience. Possession of a class "A" water treatment certificate.

Other Information:

The work requires some physical exertion such as long periods of standing; walking over rough or difficult surfaces; recurring lifting of moderately heavy items weighing less than 25 pounds and may require occasional lifting of objects weighing in excess of 25 pounds. Required valid NC drivers' license and good driving record.
