TOWN OF MOORESVILLE EASES WATER RESTRICTIONS

The Town of Mooresville made temporary changes to water restrictions today after the Catawba-Wateree Drought Management Advisory Group (CW-DMAG) recommended relaxing water restrictions for area customers.

CW-DMAG advised area water suppliers “that current conditions in the basin can accommodate up to two days a week of outdoor water use for a temporary period without significant negative impacts on water supplies.” These restrictions will be in place until November 30 unless drought conditions worsen.

“The Town of Mooresville remains in Stage III Mandatory Conservation,” said Town Manager Steve Husemann. “However, we will follow the less-restrictive, temporary measures as suggested by CW-DMAG.” Until further notice, the Town of Mooresville will allow customers to water lawns, wash cars, top off swimming pools (filling is not allowed), and run outdoor fountains two days per week on the following schedule: odd-numbered addresses on Tuesday and Saturdays; even-numbered addresses on Thursdays and Sundays.

In April, 2008, the Town Board of Commissioners amended the Emergency Water Conservation Plan giving the Town flexibility to temporarily alter restrictions and uses based on measures decided by the CW-DMAG.
