### **TOWN BEGINS DELIVERY OF RECYCLING CONTAINERS**

MOORESVILLE, N.C. – Today, the Town began delivery of nearly 6,000 blue roll-out recycling containers to residents who signed up for the Town's curbside recycling program by the September deadline. Containers are being distributed by Waste Recycling Services under contract with the manufacturer. Containers will be placed at the curb by the delivery contractor. It will take two weeks to distribute all of the containers.

“It will take until November 4 to get all of the initial containers delivered,” said John Yvars, Sanitation Superintendent. “Also, we had many people sign up after the deadline and anticipate others will register once they see containers arrive in their neighborhood. We will get these containers delivered as quickly as possible after the initial routes are set.”

Attached to the containers are Information Cards and Schedule Magnets. Residents should review all the information carefully. Recycling will be collected EVERY OTHER WEEK on a household's regular sanitation day. The schedule magnet indicates if the household is a BLUE or GREEN week recycler. Residents should post the magnet in a conspicuous place for future reference or mark the dates on a calendar to know when to roll the recycling container to the curb.
