

ORDINANCE NO. 73-9

AN ORDINANCE TO PROVIDE THAT EVERY OFFICER, AGENT AND EMPLOYEE, EXCEPT THE CITY MANAGER AND THE CITY RECORDER, HAVING DUTIES EMBRACING THE RECEIPT, DISBURSEMENT, CUSTODY OR HANDLING OF MONEY, SHALL BEFORE ENTERING UPON HIS DUTIES, EXECUTE A FIDELITY BOND WITH SOME SURETY COMPANY AUTHORIZED TO DO BUSINESS IN THE STATE OF TENNESSEE, SAID BOND TO BE IN AN AMOUNT NOT LESS THAN \$5,000.00.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF MT. JULIET, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

Every officer, agent and employee, except the City Manager and the City Recorder, having duties embracing the receipt, disbursement, custody or handling of money shall before entering upon his duties, execute a fidelity bond with some surety company authorized to do business in the State of Tennessee, said bond to be in an amount not less than \$5,000.00.

The fidelity bond so executed shall be subject to the approval of the Board of Commissioners.

The costs of making said bond are to be paid by the City of Mt. Juliet.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that this Ordinance take effect from and after its passage, the public welfare of the municipality of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee, requiring it.
