

ORDINANCE NO. 74-19

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A FIRE ENGINE; THE TAKING OF BIDS BY THE CITY MANAGER; THE ACCEPTANCE OR REJECTION OF SAME AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN A CONTRACT FOR SAID PURCHASE.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF MT. JULIET AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. That the City Manager be and he is hereby authorized to advertise and accept bids for a fire engine, the specifications for said fire engine being attached to this Ordinance and made a part of by reference. The City Manager is authorized to reject any or all bids.

SECTION 2. Upon the acceptance of the best bid by the City Manager, the Mayor shall execute a contract for the purchase of said fire engine.

SECTION 3. The City will pay for said fire engine out of funds established in the budget or if necessary may borrow money to purchase said fire engine. The Mayor is authorized to sign all notes and documents necessary to borrow funds for financing both temporary and permanent.

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, the general welfare of the City of Mt. Juliet, Wilson County, Tennessee requiring it.
