

ORDINANCE NO. 75- 3

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF MT. JULIET, TENNESSEE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACTUAL AGREEMENT WITH THE SHERIFF OF WILSON COUNTY TO HOUSE MT. JULIET CITY PRISONERS IN THE WILSON COUNTY JAIL AND TO PROVIDE FOR PAYMENT OF THEIR BOARD THEREIN. TO FURTHER AUTHORIZE THE CITY OF MT. JULIET, TENNESSEE TO PAY ALL LEGAL FEES TO PLACE PRISONERS IN JAIL AND TO RELEASE SAID PRISONERS. TO FURTHER PROVIDE THE METHOD OF PERMITTING BAIL BOND FOR SAID PRISONERS.

WHEREAS, the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee does not have a jail to incarcerate their prisoners and a need exists for the housing of said prisoners, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners believe that a need exists for the housing of said prisoners as well as authorizing the funds necessary for the jailing and boarding of said prisoners, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to make provisions for permitting bail bond for said prisoners.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF MT. JULIET, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:


SECTION 1. The Mayor of the City of Mt. Juliet is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with the Sheriff of Wilson County, Tennessee and other proper officers, if necessary, to house prisoners of the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee in the Wilson County jail. The Mayor is authorized to agree to pay \$4 per day for each prisoner which includes the prisoner's meals, plus \$1 turnkey charges for jailing the prisoner and \$1 turnkey fee to release said prisoner. Further, that the City will pay \$1 for mittimus. The contract with the county Sheriff shall provide that the above costs shall be paid even though the prisoner is not convicted.


SECTION 2. The contract shall further provide that the City of Mt. Juliet Police Department will be responsible as to the time a prisoner is locked up and as to the time he is released from the County jail. Further, that a City Police officer must sign the prisoner in and out on the City prisoner's record. This includes signing the prisoner out when bond is made.


SECTION 3. Funds for all of the above charges shall be paid from: **General Funds as budgeted under Department of City Court.**

SECTION 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, the general welfare of the City of Mt. Juliet, Wilson County, Tennessee, requiring it.






