

ORDINANCE NO. 75-8

AN ORDINANCE TO CREATE A SCHOOL PATROL AS A PART OF THE POLICE FORCE AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PRESCRIBE THEIR DUTIES AND TO SET THEIR SALARIES.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF MT. JULIET, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created within the police force for the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee two (2) positions to be known as School Patrol Officers and their appointments shall be made by the City Manager.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated the sum of \$4,000.00 out of the General Fund, same being Account No. 110-42100-III to pay the salaries of the two (2) School Patrol Officers.

SECTION 3. The two (2) School Patrol Officers shall receive \$10 per school day worked for the 175 days of the school year. Each shall be subject to Income Tax and FICA deductions.

SECTION 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, the welfare of the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee requiring it.
