

ORDINANCE NO. 75-9

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF MT. JULIET, TENNESSEE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH WILSON COUNTY, TENNESSEE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERMITTING THE FIRE TRUCK OWNED BY THE CITY OF MT. JULIET, TENNESSEE AND ITS EMPLOYEES TO SERVE CITIZENS OF WILSON COUNTY OUTSIDE THE CITY LIMITS OF MT. JULIET AND WILSON COUNTY, TENNESSEE ACTING BY AND THROUGH ITS CIVIL DEFENSE DEPARTMENT SHALL FURNISH ONE OR MORE EMPLOYEES ON A 24-HOUR BASIS TO MAN SAID FIRE TRUCK AND TO TEACH MT. JULIET EMPLOYEES OR VOLUNTEERS TO USE SAID TRUCK FOR FIGHTING FIRES BOTH WITHIN AND OUTSIDE THE CITY OF MT. JULIET, TENNESSEE AND TO PROVIDE FOR CANCELLATION OF SAID CONTRACT.

WHEREAS, the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee has purchased a fire truck and desires to use same within the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee and to aid those citizens of Wilson County, Tennessee and to enter into a contract with the Civil Defense Department of Wilson County and,

WHEREAS, the Quarterly County Court of Wilson County, Tennessee under Resolution Number 5-75-4 authorized the Law Enforcement and Civil Defense Committee of the County Court and the County Judge to negotiate and execute a contract with the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee in regard to the joint operation of a fire truck in the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee and the area west of Highway 109, Wilson County, Tennessee and where an emergency or disaster may exist in said county.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF MT. JULIET, TENNESSEE AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The Mayor of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee is authorized by this ordinance to enter into a contract with the County Judge of Wilson County, Tennessee and any other necessary parties to said contract for the purpose of establishing a joint operation of the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee fire truck in the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee and the area west of Highway 109 in Wilson County, Tennessee and where an emergency or disaster may exist.

SECTION 2. The contract to be signed by the Mayor is attached hereto and made a part of this ordinance as if quoted fully herein verbatim.

SECTION 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance based on the fact that the fire engine may be called upon for use in the fighting of fires at any time.

SECTION 4. That this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, the welfare of the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee requiring it.

CONTRACT

This contract entered into this 1st day of August, 1975 for the mutual benefit of the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee and Wilson County, Tennessee for the joint operation of the City of Mt. Juliet fire truck in the City of Mt. Juliet and the area west of Highway 109 in Wilson County, Tennessee and where an emergency or disaster may exist in said county.

It is agreed that Wilson County shall, through its Civil Defense Department, furnish one or more men on a 24-hour per day basis to man the Mt. Juliet Fire Department and to furnish competent instructors to teach regular firemen or volunteer firemen how to operate the fire truck and how to fight fires.

It is further agreed that the Mt. Juliet fire truck will be housed by the City of Mt. Juliet and that said City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee will pay for the necessary gas, oil, equipment and repairs to make said fire engine operative.

This contract may be ended upon 30 days notice given each to the other by either the Mayor of Mt. Juliet or the County Judge of Wilson County, Tennessee.
