

ORDINANCE NO. 75-12

AN ORDINANCE TO INCREASE THE YEARLY SALARY OF THE CITY MANAGER FROM \$3,600 TO \$7,200 PER YEAR AND AMEND THE BUDGET ACCORDINGLY.

WHEREAS, the City Manager's work load has increased, and WHEREAS, the work load has more than doubled in time spent on the city's business, it is the opinion of the City Commissioners that the yearly salary of the City Manager be increased.

THEREFORE, be it ORDAINED by the City of Mt. Juliet that the City Manager's yearly salary increase from \$3,600 per year to \$7,200 per year.

That the budget be amended accordingly.

Be it further ORDAINED that this ordinance take effect for and after its passage, the welfare of the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee requiring it.
