

ORDINANCE NO. 76-15

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 73-12, AS AMENDED, TO CREATE THE POSITION OF ASSISTANT CHIEF OF POLICE; TO ESTABLISH THE DUTIES OF THE ASSISTANT CHIEF OF POLICE; TO REPEAL SECTION 4 OF ORDINANCE NO. 73-12, AS AMENDED, IN ITS ENTIRETY; AND TO CREATE A NEW SECTION 4 ESTABLISHING THE RATE OF PAY OF THE CHIEF OF POLICE, THE ASSISTANT CHIEF OF POLICE AND THE PATROLMEN AND TO ESTABLISH THE DATES OF BEGINNING PAY FOR SAID OFFICER CLASSIFICATION, AND TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR PAYMENT OF SAID SALARIES HEREIN SET OUT.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF MT. JULIET, TENNESSEE, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. There is hereby created in the Police Department the position of Assistant Chief of Police, as of November 1, 1976. The Assistant Chief of Police duties shall be the same as those existing for police officers and any other duties specifically designated by the Chief of Police.

SECTION 2. Section 4 of Ordinance No. 73-12, as amended, is hereby repealed in its entirety and the following shall be substituted in lieu thereof.

"Salaries of Police Force. (a) The Chief of Police shall receive \$600.00 per month as his salary and beginning January 1, 1977, he shall receive \$700.00 per month as his salary.

(b) The Assistant Chief of Police shall receive \$600.00 per month as his salary, beginning November 1, 1976, and \$650.00 per month salary beginning January 1, 1977.

(c) Patrolmen shall receive \$550.00 per month salary and beginning January 1, 1977, shall receive \$600.00 per month salary."

SECTION 3. The Police salaries set out herein shall be paid out of the Police Fund, same being Account No. 42100-111

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, the welfare of the City of Mt. Juliet, Tennessee requiring it.
